

## Storm Damage

On Wednesday, July 10 at about 6:30 am a strong wind storm passed through southern Washington and Marshall Counties. Winds at Linn, KS were reported as 100 mph and winds at Blue Rapids were reported as 70 mph. The town of Blue Rapids had major damage to trees and vehicles on which trees fell.

An inspection run on the rails east of Blue Rapids identified a downed tree on the rails just east of the field crossing a half mile or so east of the Vista RD crossing.



When Gene Harding and Dave Crawford went out to cut that tree they had no idea what lied beyond. Over a period of 3 mornings they cut 26 trees across the tracks. Some of them were in the 6-8 inch diameter range and some were in the 12-15 inch diameter range.



Gene and his wife Sandy also did some cutting of trees west of Waterville. They didn't make it past the Coon Creek bridge because of a tree down on the west end of the bridge. At this time it is yet to be determines how to deal with that tree.
