The rail ride will run west out of Waterville to "Somewhere". There will be a campfire and musical entertainment for you to enjoy before you return to Waterville. "Somewhere" is an open area where the Waterville Lions club donated a 20ft x 20 ft shelter for the railroad to use for events.

Anniversary Coin

The Central Branch Railroad was incorporated by the Kansas Territorial Legislature in February 1859 with the authority to build west to the Kansas-Colorado border towards Pikes Peak or Denver. To commemorate the 160th anniversary of the Central Branch Railroad, we have commissioned a limited edition collector coin. The engraved solid brass coin was designed by professional graphic artist Barbra Agnew who has done work for Disney Studios. The coin is 2.5 inches in diameter and production is limited to 160 coins. They will be available for a \$20.00 donation each and will come with a brief history of the Central Branch Railroad. The coins will be available beginning April 7 during the 160th Anniversary celebration and for a few weeks after until they are all sold.
