#### Grade Crossing Fundraiser

There are two crossings on Genessee ST in Blue Rapids and the Nebraska and Colorado Street crossings in Waterville that we need to replace. The Kansas Ave crossing in Waterville was replaced with asphalt in the fall of 2018 and spring of 2019. A rough estimate of the cost is \$2,000 per crossing. MCRHS has matching funds available and have set up a GoFundMe Charity fundraiser. A more long term goal would be to also put in a hard surface grade crossing on Vista RD, east of Blue Rapids. ### **Volunteers Needed**

MCRHS began with a small group of people meeting in the Waterville RR depot in the fall of 1999. Articles of Incorporation were filed with the Kansas Secretary of State in May of 2000. MCRHS began offering rides on the CBRR in 2002. Many of the currently active volunteers have been with the organization since its inception. Quoting one of those members, "age tends to curb enthusiasm and physical abilities".



It is not only the number of active volunteers but also their physical ability that is placing some limitations on how much work on grade crossings and other maintenance MCRHS can do without hiring outside help.

MCRHS has a wonderful experience to offer. There are only a few places in Kansas where the public can ride on historic rails like the Central Branch RR. It is possible that the rails between Blue Rapids and Waterville are the same rails laid in 1867-1868. None of the other places in Kansas provide a better scenic ride, especially with the crossing of the Big Blue River.

We could use some new volunteers. It doesn't take much training to become an engineer and drive a motorcar down the track. We can also use volunteers to flag vehicle traffic at crossings (the ride is free!!) and if you would like to enjoy nature and help trim tree limbs we would welcome that as well.
